Managers Summary

From a Managers perspective, it was a pleasure to look after these boys over the last couple of weeks. I want to make special mention of Luke, Brooke and Isaac who helped us out against Northland and hopefully we can see them come up through next year as our Year 8 boys move on. There are 7 x Year 8 boys so it will be a very new look team next year but I expect Harry, Ben, Ethan, Cohen and Dylan as our Year 7's to be key leaders in our team next year. I suspect we played against mainly Year 8 boys (and men!) so we should be better for it in 2017.

Too many extras is a common theme with 167 extras in 157 overs. Over 1 extra an over. Opposition scored 687 runs against us with extras making up nearly 25% or a quarter of the runs.

We also only batted the 40 overs once leaving plenty of runs out there. So 2 basic targets to improve on.

Plenty to work on but we will be better for this experience. It will be neat to see these boys together again perhaps in a couple of years in the Year 9-10 fixtures.

The Stats

All the boys contribute significantly over the 5 games but I do want to recognise a few key players.

Viren Patel was our top run scorer with 96 runs averaging 24. He certainly has the capacity to win games on his own with the bat. His total runs ranked him 9th overall in the ND Stats.

Matthew Veitch with 8 wickets for 62 runs at an average of 7.75. His stats ranked him 4th for bowling in the overall ND players. His leadership must also be mentioned as he continues to develop.

Angus Veitch was voted our MVP with his controlled spin bowling keeping us in games as he picked up wickets and dried up the runs. He picked up 6 wickets and his economy rate was 2.84 runs per over.
